

## SWINE FLU UPDATE

We would like all our parents to be fully informed about our plans in the event of any pupils or employees being affected by swine flu.

We anticipate that there will be no closure of King's College School ("KCS"), King's College Junior School ("KCJS"), Wimbledon Common Prep School ("Squirrels") or The Rowans unless so directed by the relevant authorities. Such a decision would follow an individual risk assessment of the school, following HPA advice.

In the event of the school being closed we would place information on our website regarding:

- the collection of any anti-viral drugs to be administered
- the collection of any work to be done by the pupils
- the impact on boys in KCS and KCJS who are sitting external examinations, including Common Entrance. On this matter, we would act in liaison with the relevant examination authorities

If the school were to be closed, the internal examinations, scheduled for the week following the summer half-term break for boys in KCS and KCJS, would be modified depending on the duration of the closure.

In order to enable Senior School boys to continue their studies at home, teachers would send work to their school email address, which can be accessed from any internet connection. Boys would be expected to check their email twice a day and complete all the work set.

Schemes of work for all subjects and all year groups in KCJS are available on the parents' section of the school website.

For those parents who do not have access to the internet, information would be given to them over the telephone.
